THE OBJECTIVE:

Starting from a chunk of iron and using fire and hammer to shape a fixed blade, drop nose hunting knife. You will learn basic metallurgy: soften, shape, harden, temper, normalize and sharpen your knife; Leathersmithing: fit, cutout, tool, sew leather sheath.

YOU RECEIVE:

1 chunk of 5160 iron (spring steel), 2 brass rivets, 2 wood slabs (for handle), epoxy, 1 mill bastard file, sandpaper 36, 120, 220, 400 grit, #2 cow hide leather, sewing thread and needles.

36 hours of instructions by Jim Brown...and fellowship.

NOTE: If you would like to use an antler handle, you must supply your own antler.

SAFETY FIRST:

You must supply your own safety glasses or goggles and light and tight work gloves. Heavy gloves tend to get in the way. **NO GLOVES = NO HAMMER**

NOTE: if you wear eye glasses you may want to get goggles instead of safety glasses.

Hot coffee and water will be provided. Bring your own snacks
